8. Competition Rule

IBD rule that are effective on the period of the competition will apply to the matches.

9. Competition System

Singles and Pairs of all classes will be based on round-robin and final rankings will be determined by winning of tournament.

9.1 Game Duration

Singles and Pairs will be played for 2 hours. Training facilities will be officially opened 14 October 10:00 - 17:00. The practicing time will not be included in the duration.

9.2 Singles

Each player rolls 4 balls and the winner will be the person who gets 21 points in the match.

9.3 Pairs

Each team rolls 4 balls and the winning team will be determined after finishing 18 ends.

9.4 Scoring

1. The winner / winning team gets 2 points and 1 point is given for draws.
2. The player / team getting the most points wins the event.
3. For players / teams with the same point, winners / winning teams will be determined by scoring differences.
4. For players / teams with the same point and scoring differences, winner / winning teams will be determined by the following:
 - 4.1 Number of winning matches
 - 4.2 Total score
5. According to criteria of the clause 4, when players/ teams are same points, they will play an extra 1 end to determine winner/winning team.

11. Information of Competition

Detailed information on matches is available from the information desk. The information desk is located at competition venue and hotel.

12. Competition Result

The schedule of the day and the result of the game are transmitted through the board.

Scoring sheets signed by both players and maker will be signed by the referee for final confirmation and submitted to headquarters.

Headquarters will receive the scoring sheets from the referees and send a copy of sheets to the processing room.

Another copy of sheets will be adjusted manually by scorekeepers for comparison with data to prepare the final records.

13. Victory Ceremony

The ceremony will not be awarded on a day-to-day, but it will be held at 16:00 on October 19 which is the last day of the competition. A closing ceremony is held immediately after the victory ceremony.

National performances and flags will be hoisted in the victory ceremony, (the winner is centered, the second is the right, and the third is the left)

14. Protest

Complaints appeals shall be placed in accordance with IBD rules and regulations.
